The Commissioner for Children and Young People, Helen Connolly, was appointed recently and is responsible for promoting and advocating for the rights, needs and wellbeing of children and young people across South Australia.

Since the official launch of the 'Listening Tour' on 15 June 2017, the Commissioner has held 21 face-to face consultations and met with more than 300 children and young people.

Helen is speaking with as many young people in finding out what is important to them through meetings, surveys and events. The information gathered helps her to understand what they like or don't like about living in SA and more importantly what they think the Children's Commissioner should do to help make life better for young South Australians.

The Commissioner is taking her Listening Tour to the town of Port Pirie from 19 July – 20 July. Helen will be talking with and meeting a diverse group of children and young people.

Children and young people of South Australia are experts in their own lives and want to have their opinions heard, treated with respect and taken seriously.

The Commissioner is committed to supporting SA children and young people to be involved in decision-making that affects them, giving particular consideration to the needs and voices of vulnerable and at-risk children and young people.

The Listening Tour will conclude end of September. A report on the voices of children and young people will inform the work produced by the office of the Commissioner.
